



An observed trial is a motorcycle competition based on skill rather than speed. The object is to ride through marked 'sections' consisting of tight turns, hill climbs, rock & logs in balance and control. Each time a rider uses his feet to regain his balance points are assessed. The trial consists of a number of sections connected by a short loop. In local competition, 8 sections and 5 laps comprise the contest. Riders are classified by ability (i.e., Rookie, Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Expert and Senior Classes).
